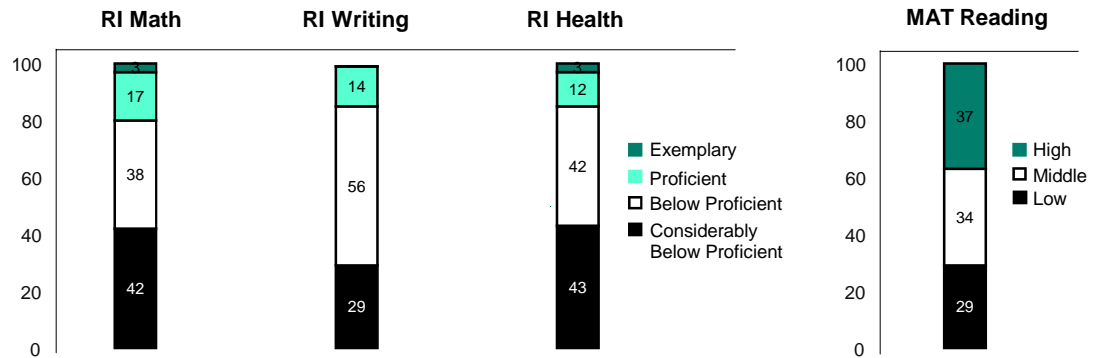


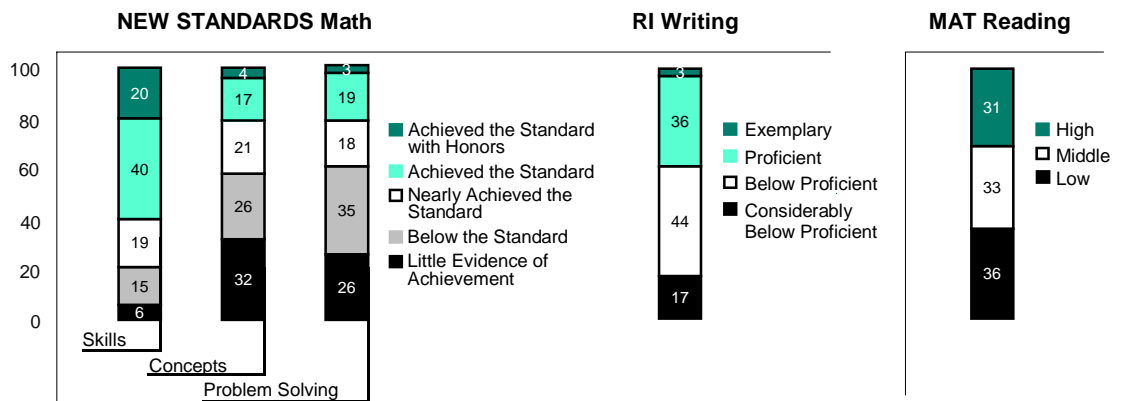

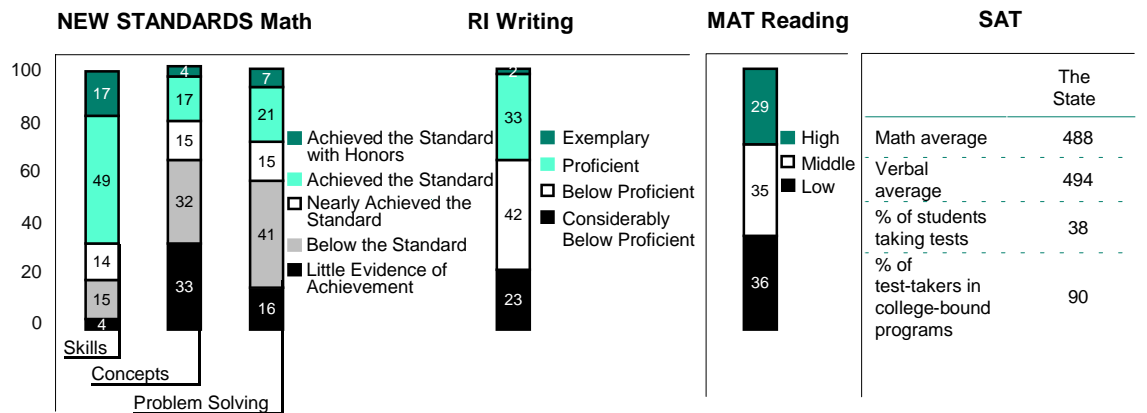
Percentage of students at each performance level on the grade 4 assessments



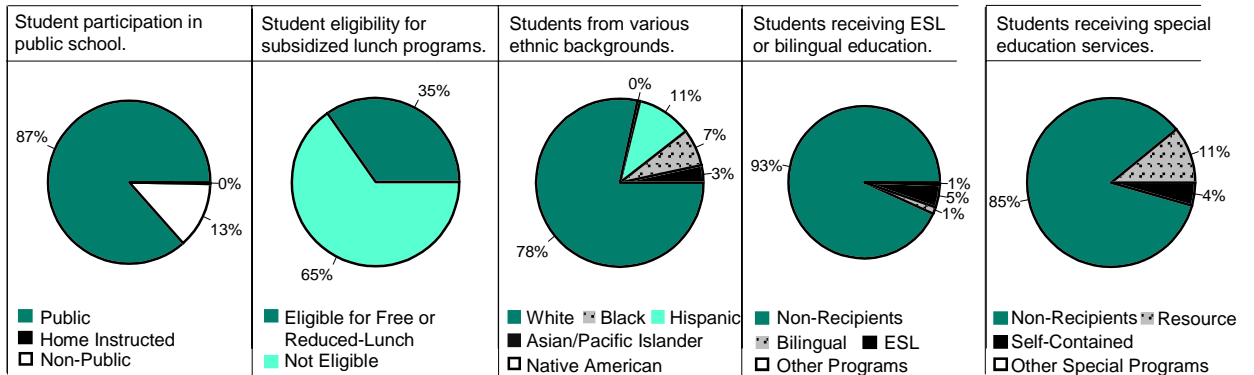
Percentage of students at each performance level on the grade 8 assessments

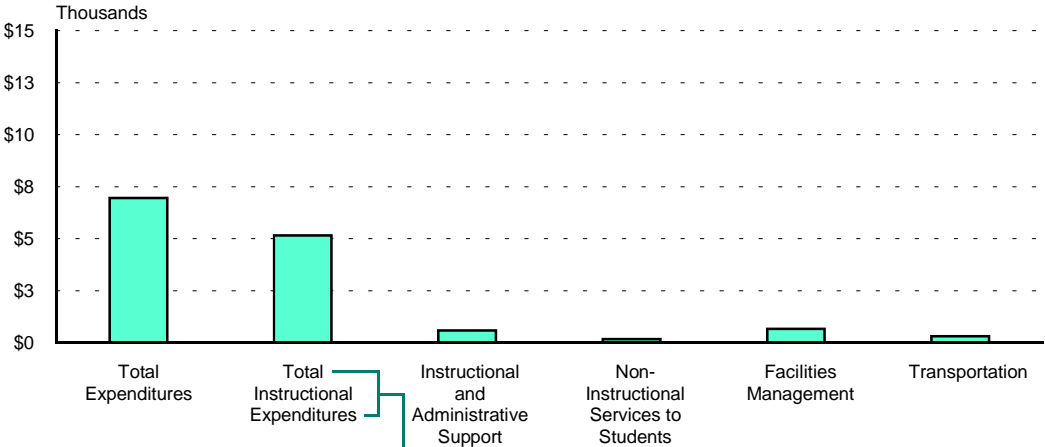

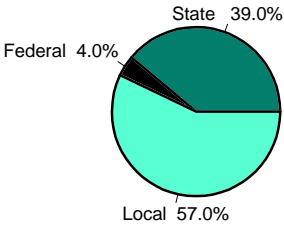
