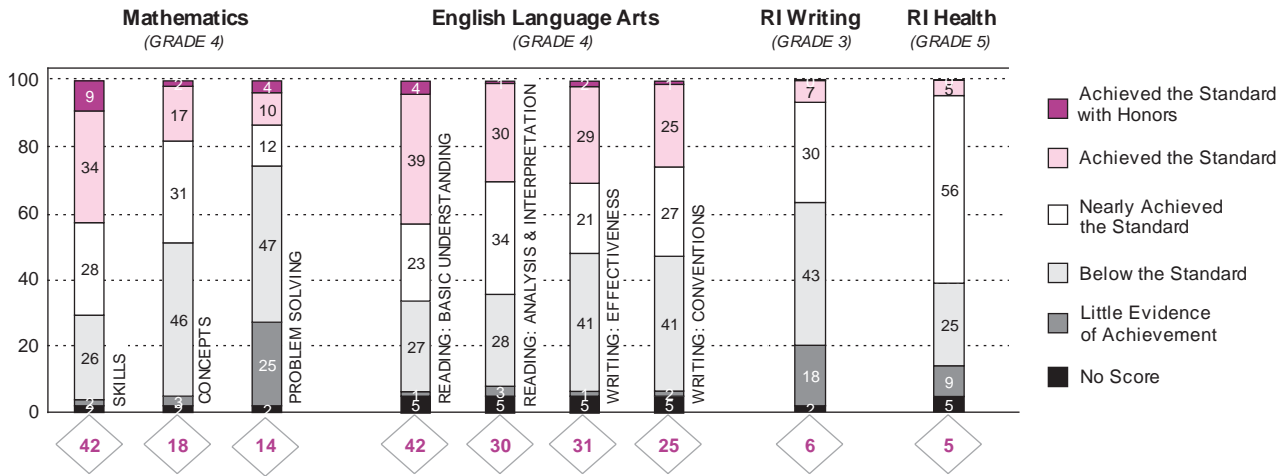

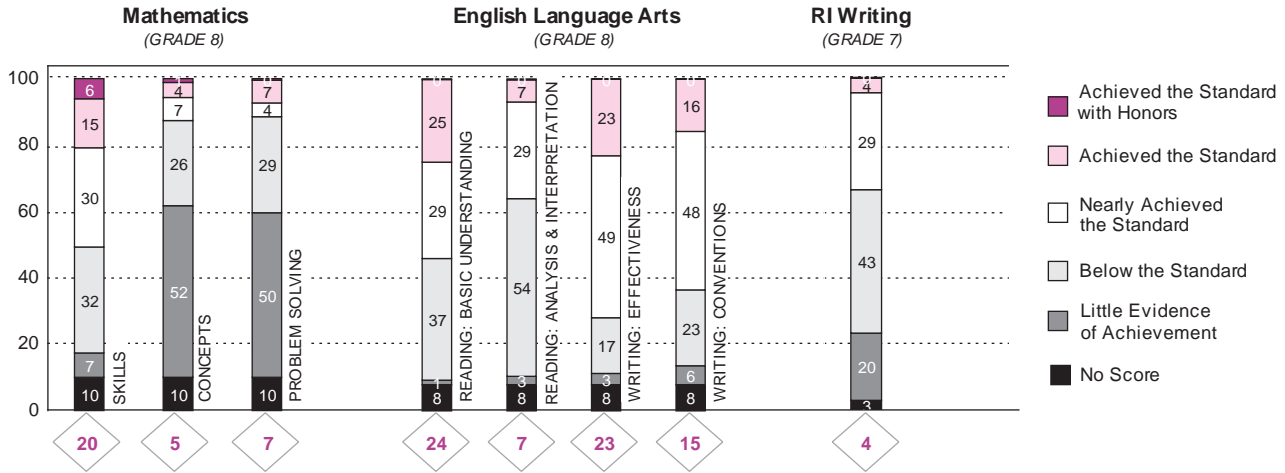

Percentage of eligible students with disabilities at each performance level on the elementary school assessments



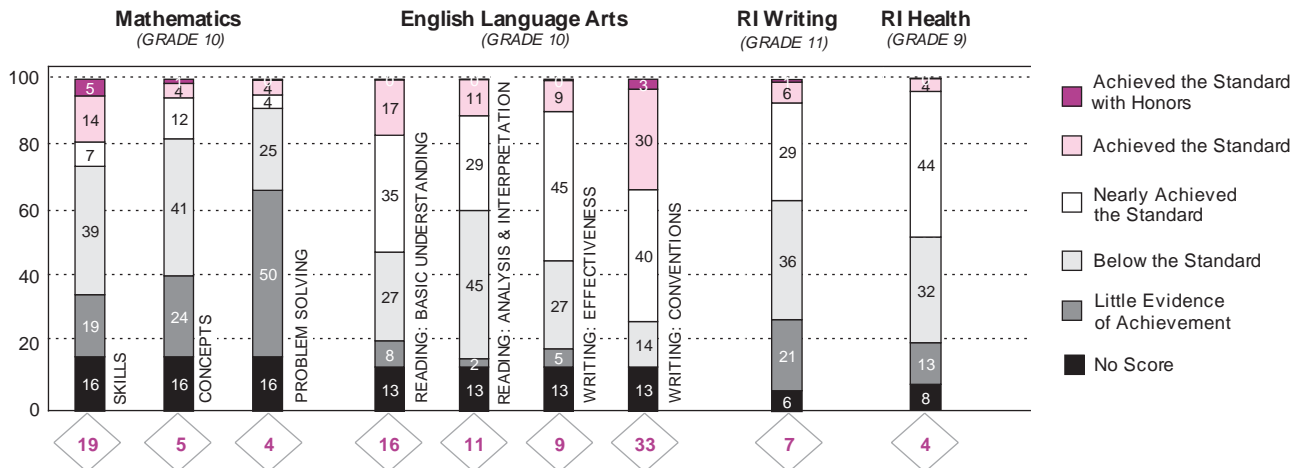
Indicates the percent of students with disabilities who met or exceeded the standard, including those who took an alternate assessment

Percentage of eligible students with disabilities at each performance level on the middle school assessments



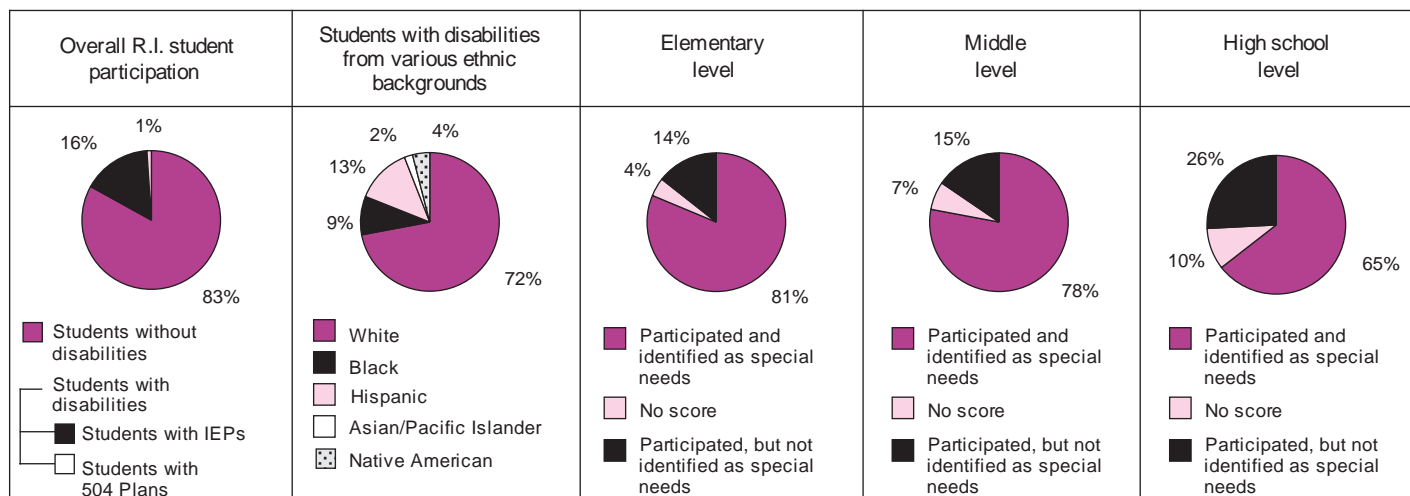
Indicates the percent of students with disabilities who met or exceeded the standard, including those who took an alternate assessment

Participation of students with disabilities on the English Language Arts New Standards Reference Exam

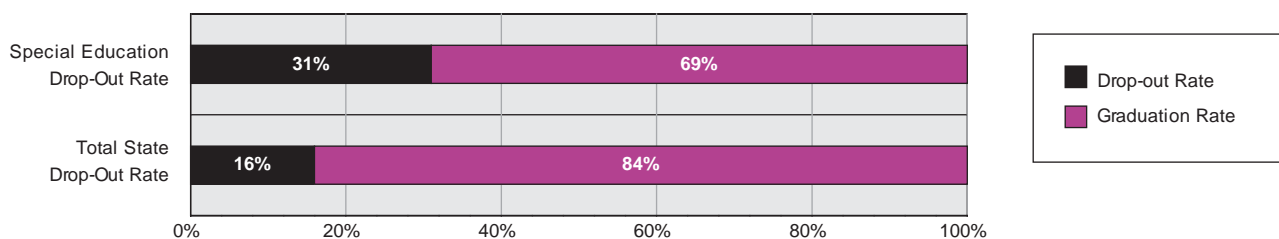

Special Education Drop-Out Rate



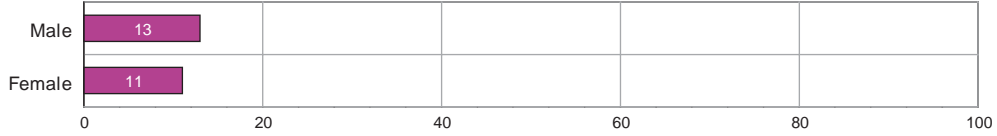
Alternate Assessment Performance in the State of Rhode Island

Percent of students achieving the standard

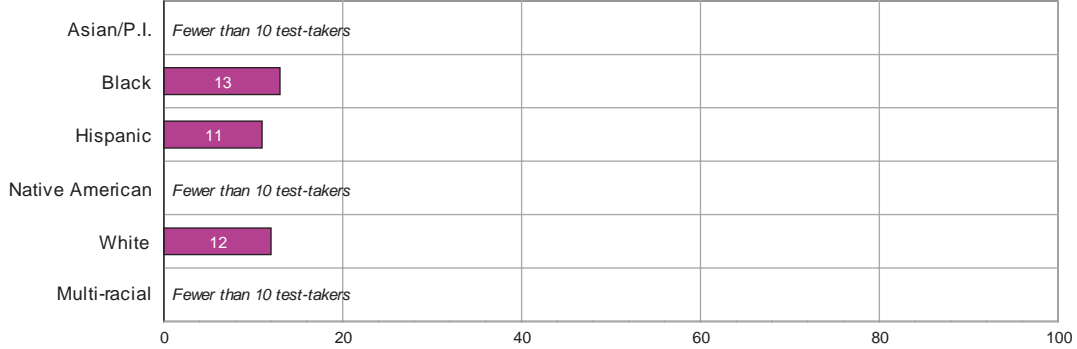
Overall State Proficiency



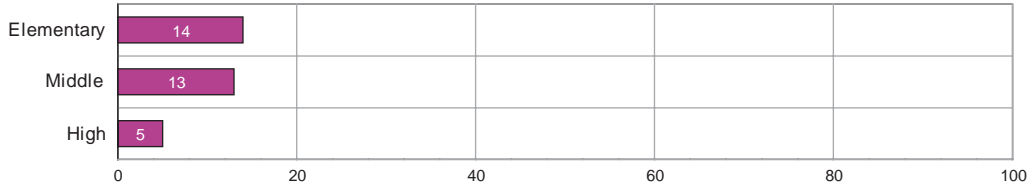
Gender



Race/Ethnicity



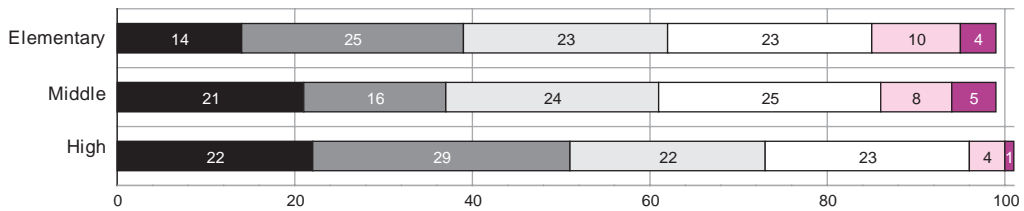
Grade Levels
