

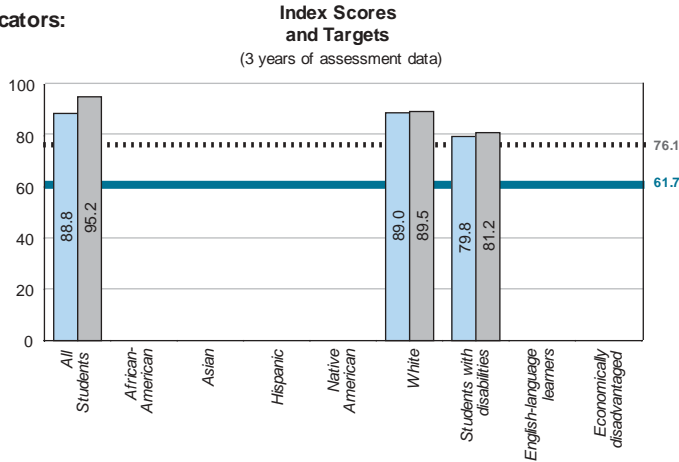

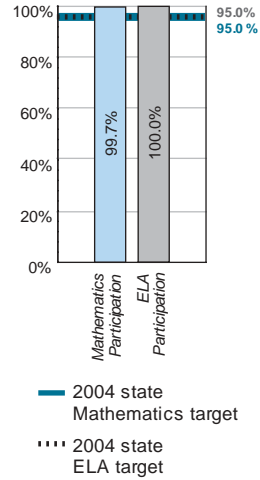

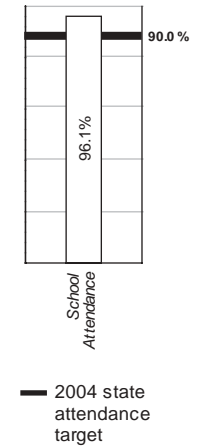
Participation Rates and Targets

(1 year of data)



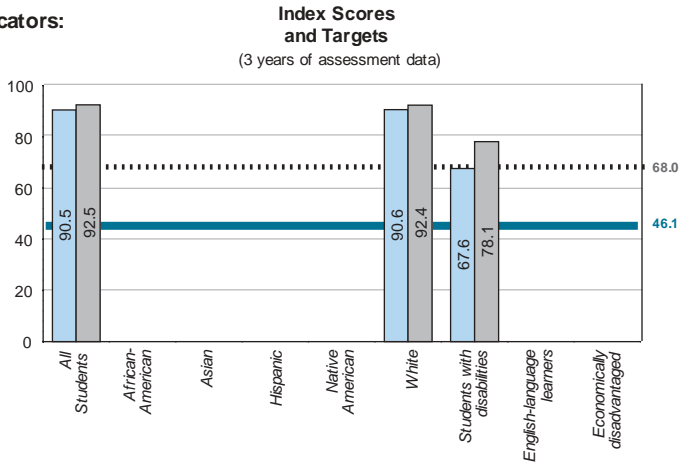

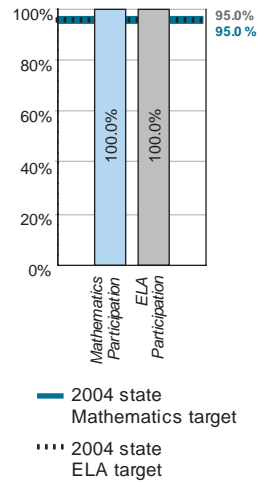

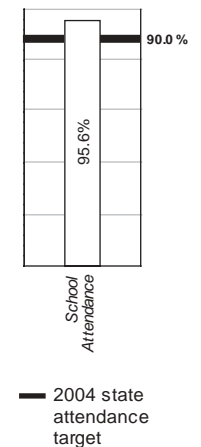
Participation Rates and Targets

(1 year of data)



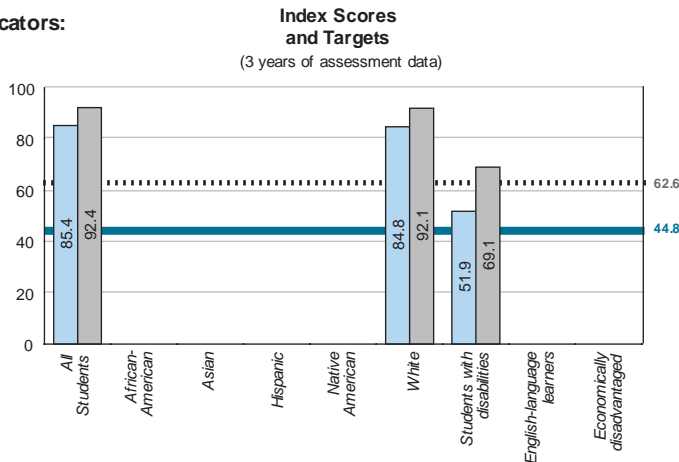

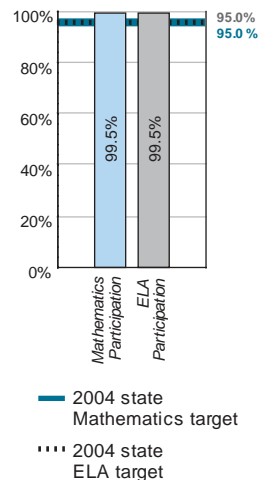
