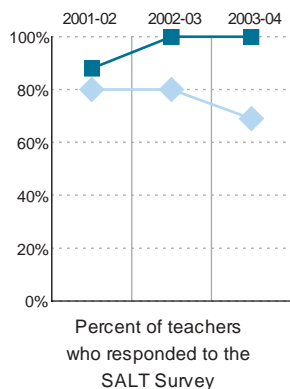
Highly qualified teachers

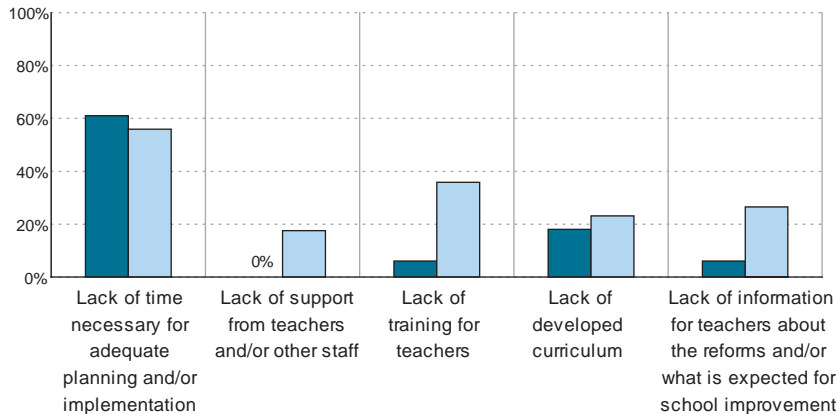
Teacher Participation Rates

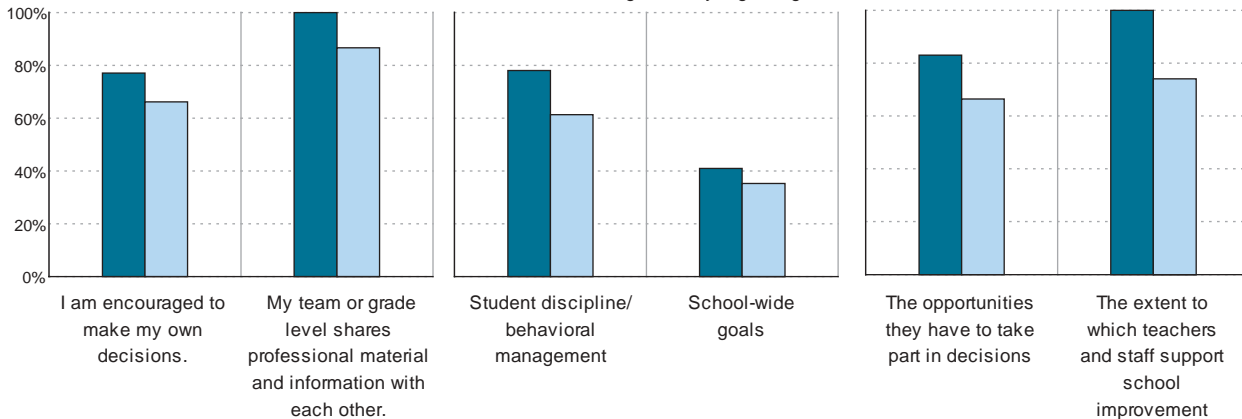
Percent of teachers who say they agree or strongly agree that:
