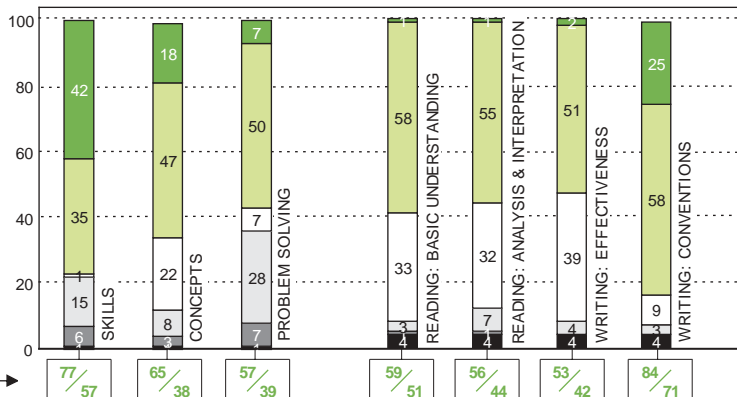
Percentage of students at each performance level

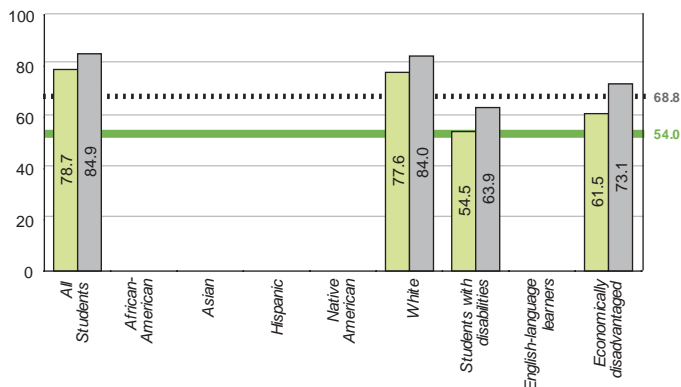

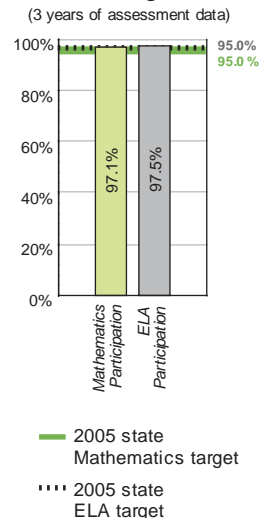

Index Scores and Targets (3 years of assessment data)

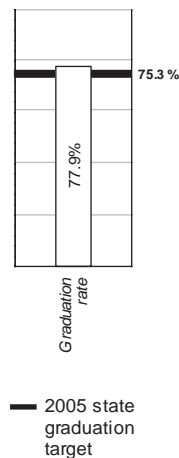

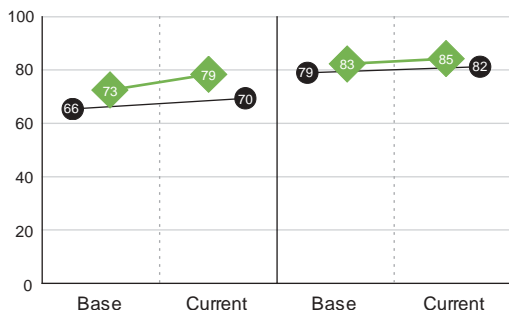
