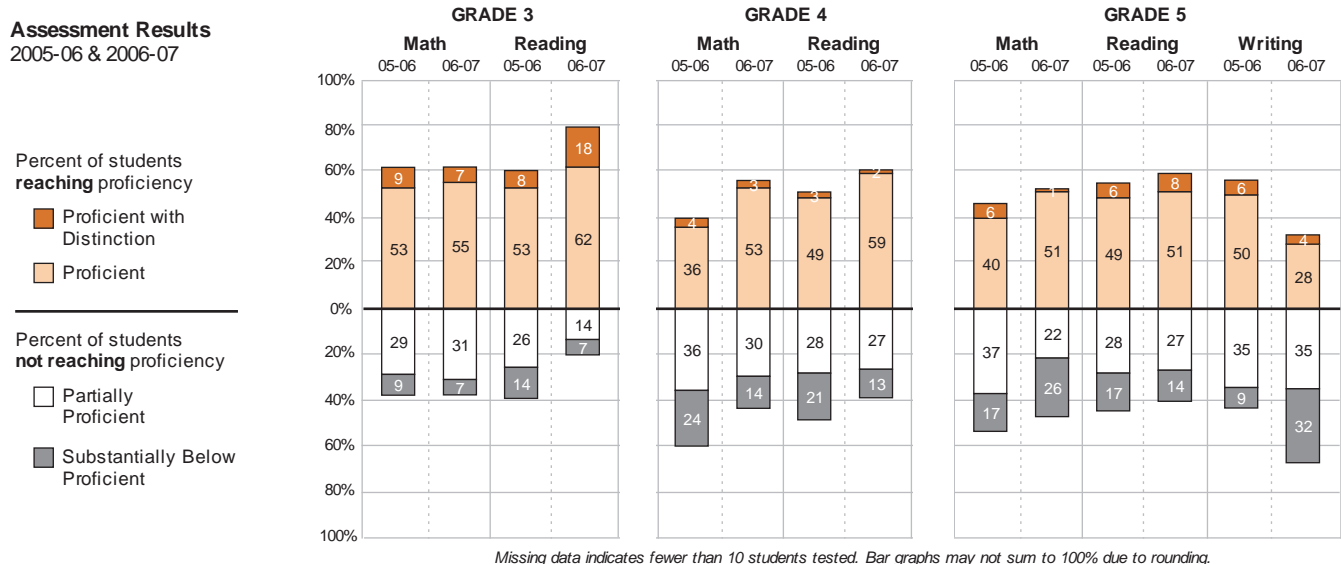

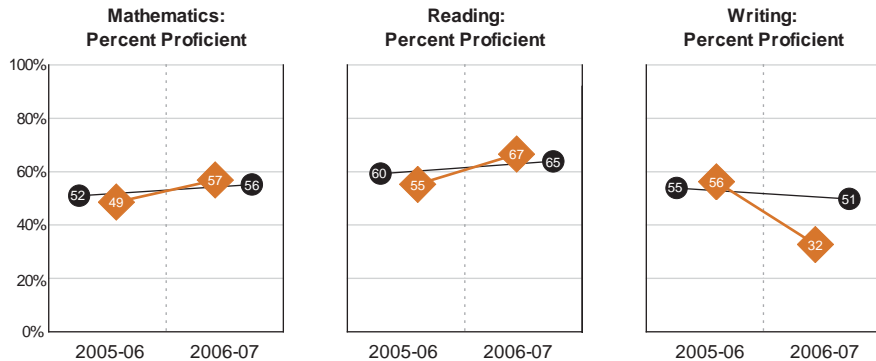
## Assessment Results 2005-06 & 2006-07
