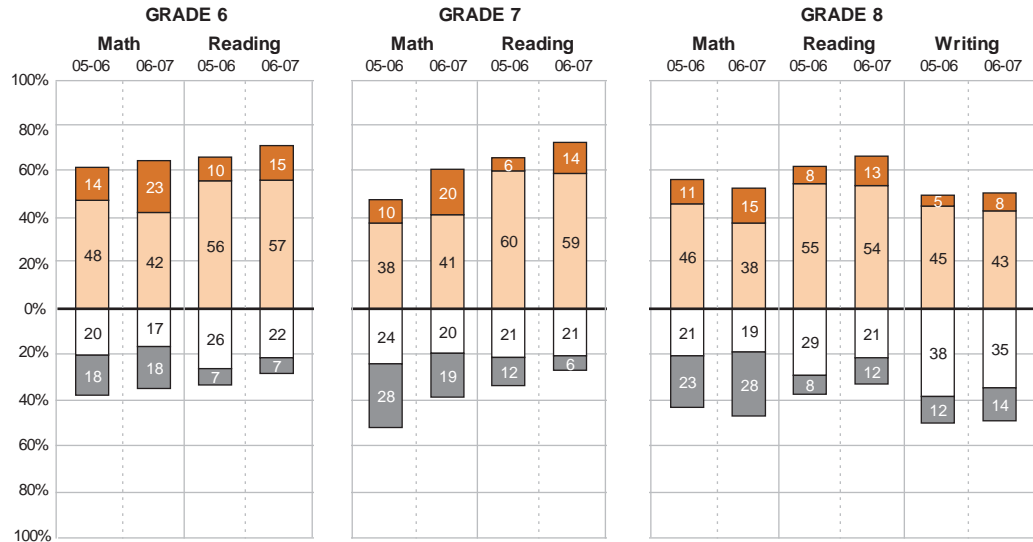

- Substantially Below Proficient

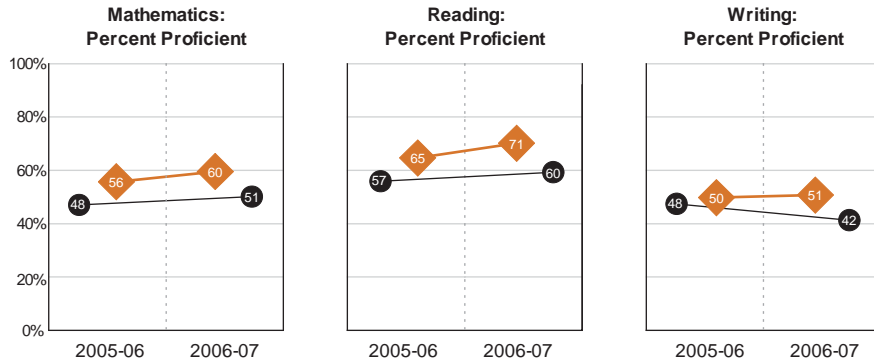

Proficiency by Student Characteristics

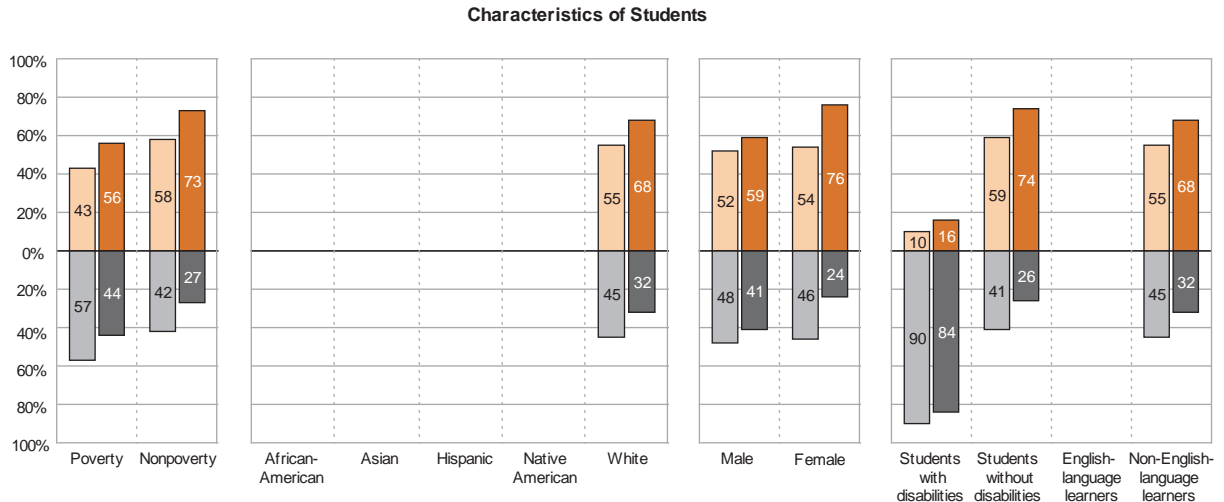
