



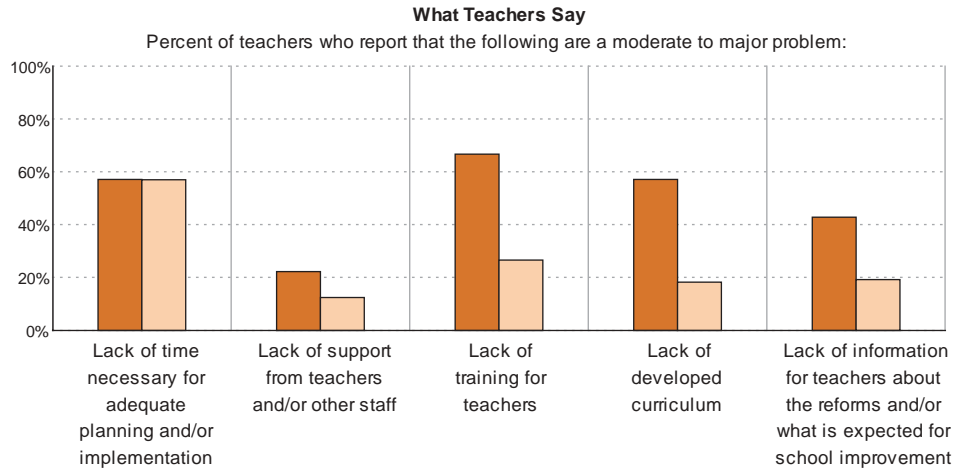
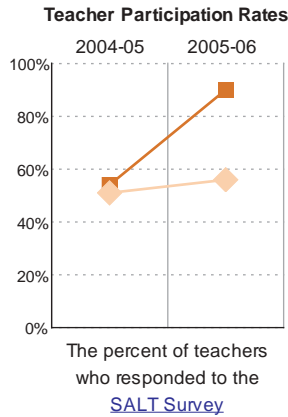
Highly qualified teachers

 R.I. elementary schools

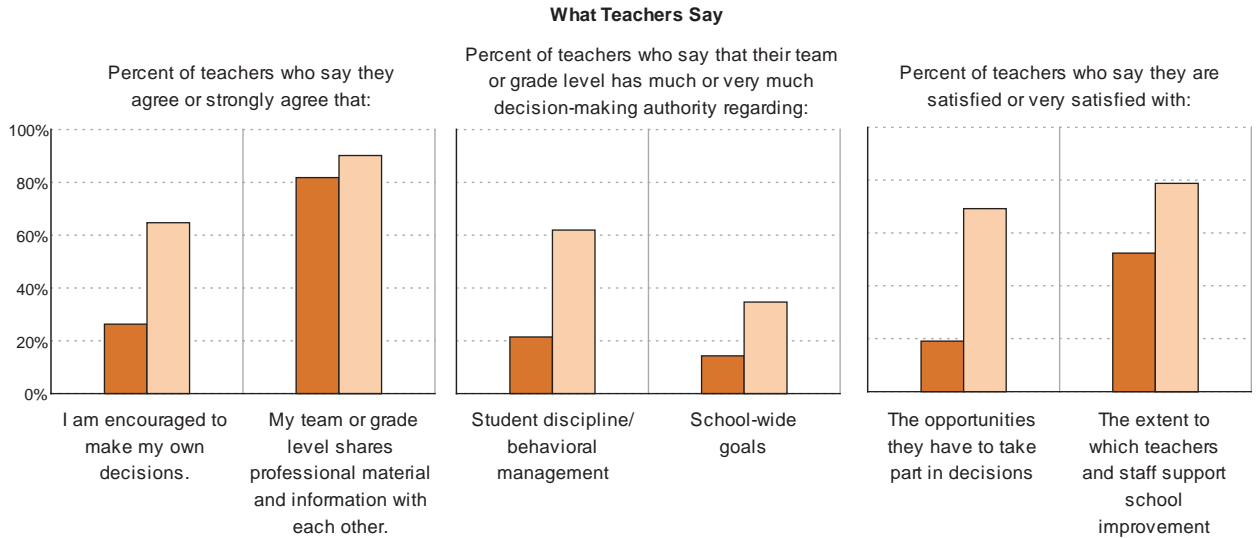
