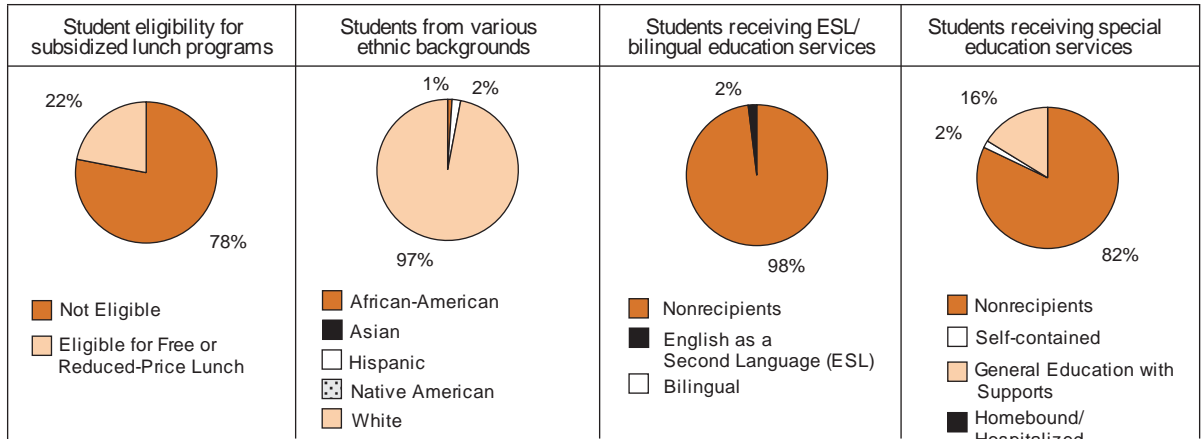




Data to Drive Decisions

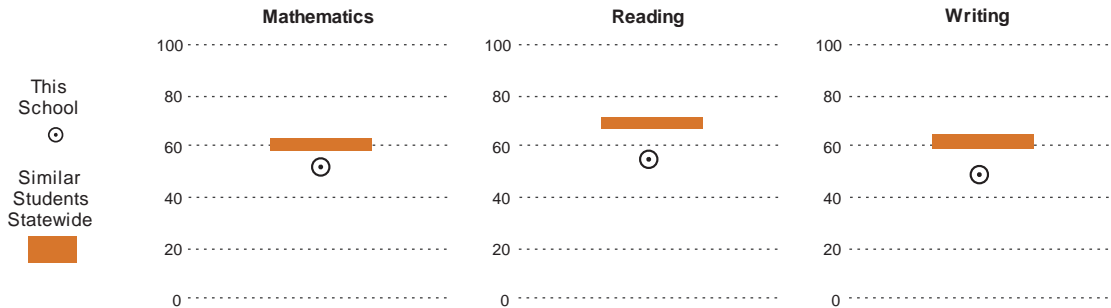
Characteristics of students attending this school



Value-Added Indicators

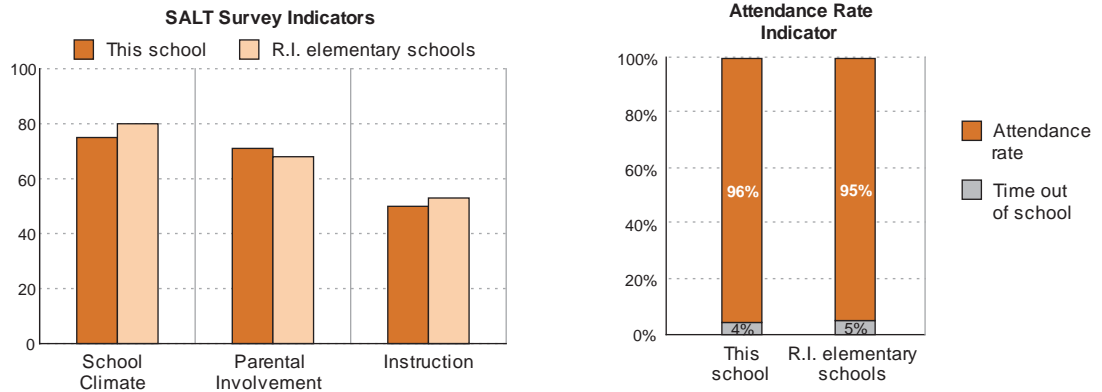
2005-06: Grade 5
