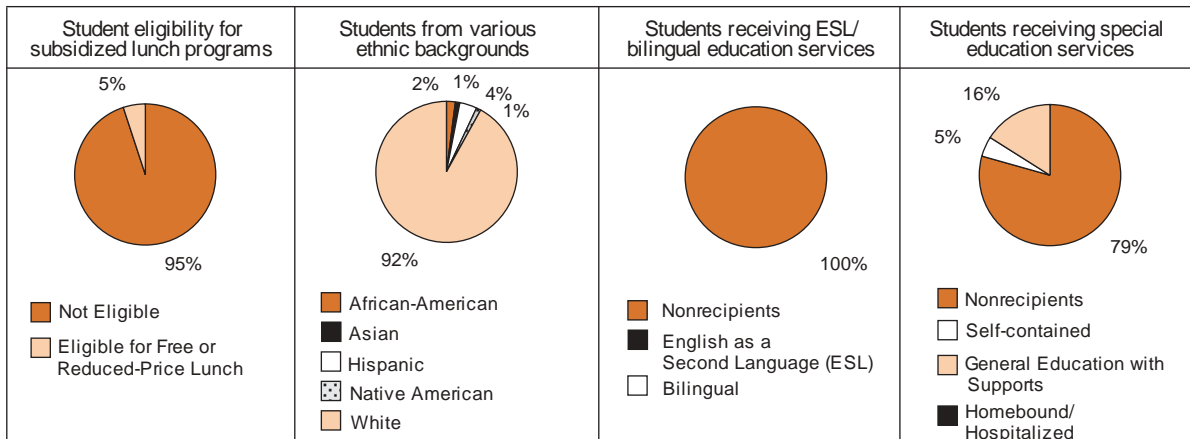




Data to Drive Decisions

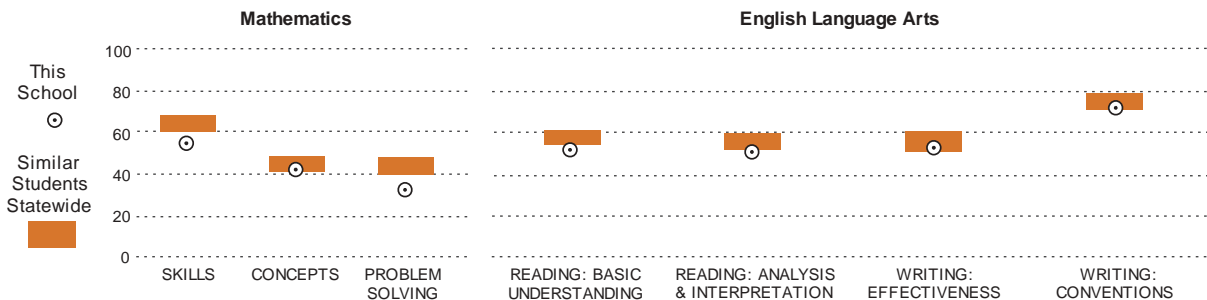
Characteristics of students attending this school

2005-06: Grade 11

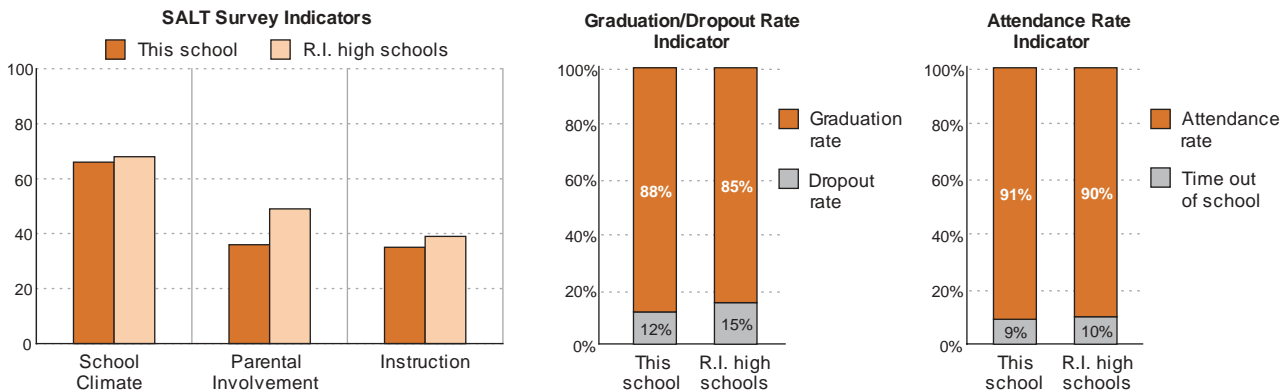
Percentage of students who met or exceeded the standard compared with the percentage of similar students statewide
