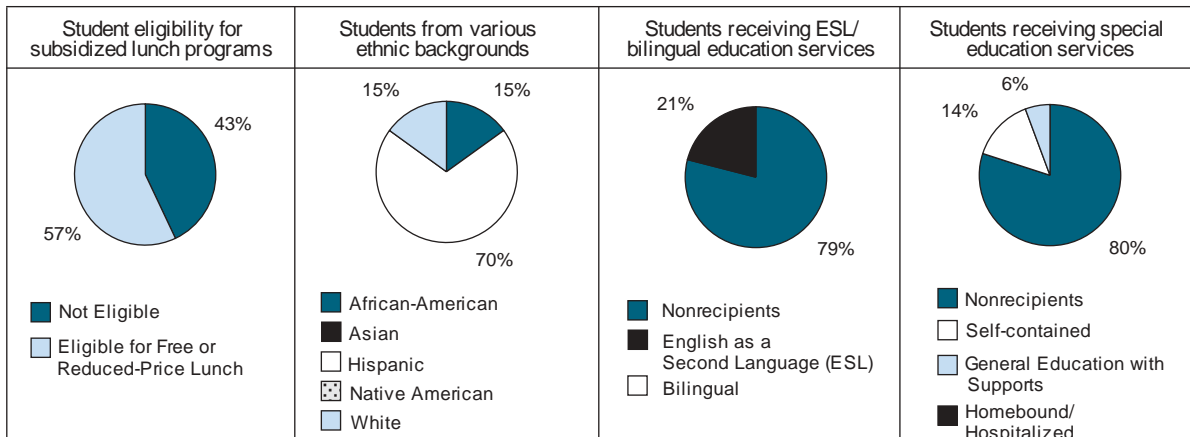




Data to Drive Decisions

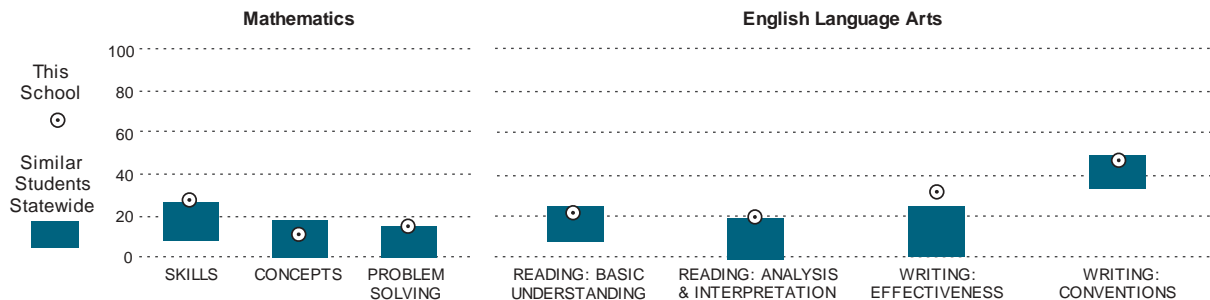
Characteristics of students attending this school



Value-Added Indicators

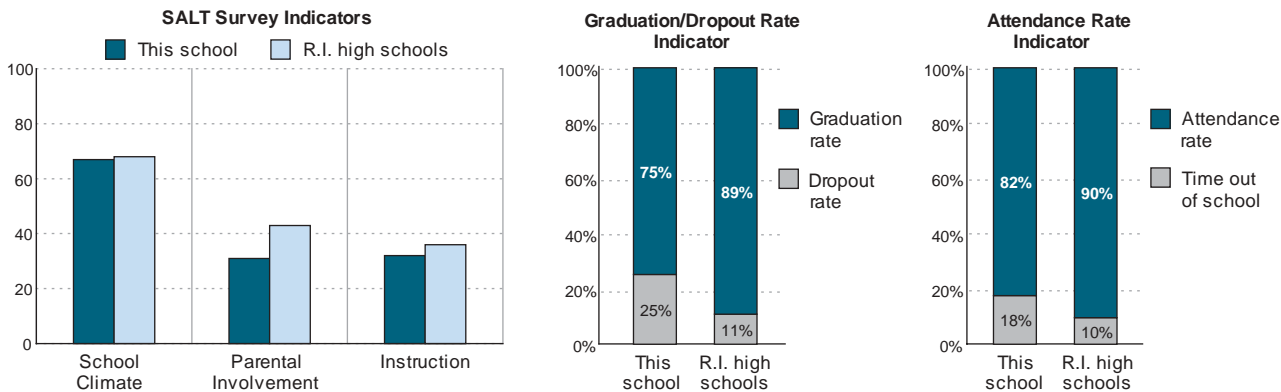
2006-07: Grade 11
