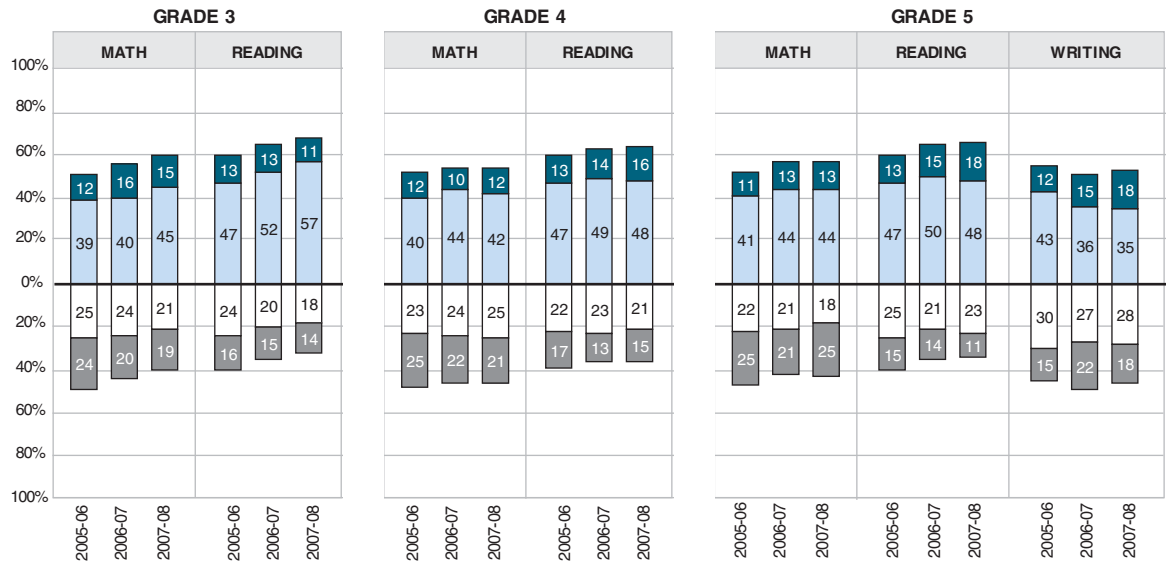
Percent of students reaching proficiency

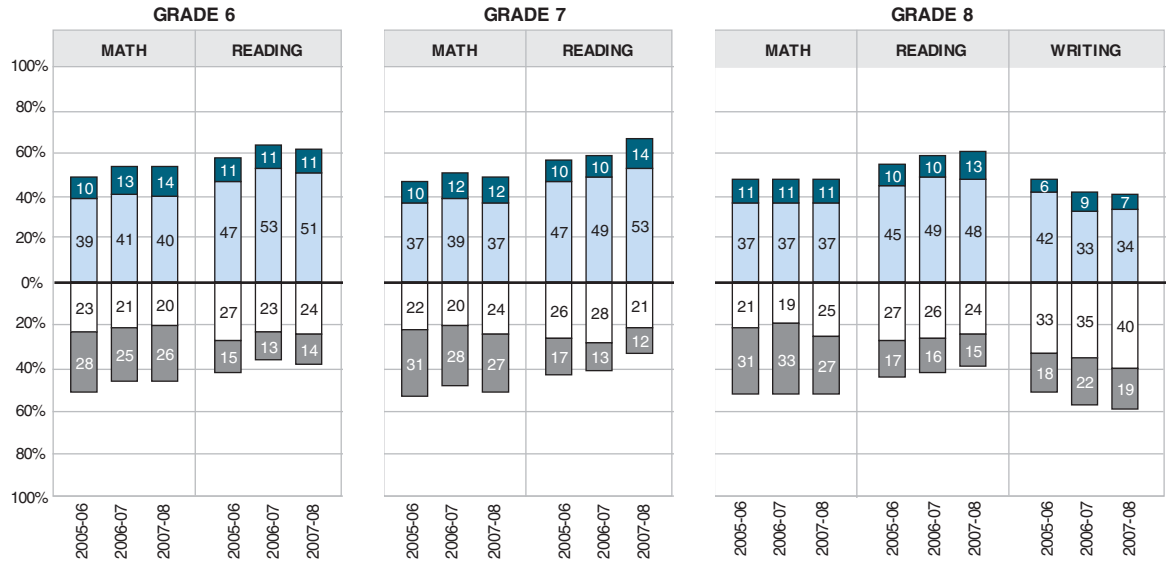
Percent of students reaching proficiency

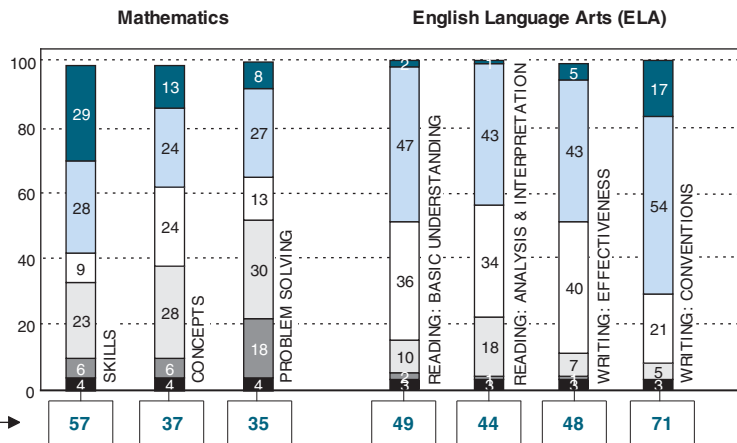


## High Schools: Assessment Results
